

## **Vintage Road Racing Association (VRRRA) Riders School**

The VRRRA in conjunction with Racing Associates Canada Events (RACE) will present a school to instruct basic riding skills for organized road racing competition. Riders who successfully pass this course will be eligible to apply for a VRRRA racing membership. Successful completion of this school will also allow the rider to purchase a RACE licence. Riders under the age of 18 years at the time of the scheduled school must contact the VRRRA to obtain an underage consent form prior to application.

### **Date and Location**

Friday June 5th, 2009 at Shannonville Motorsports Park

### **Directions**

Take the 401 East of Belleville, Ontario to the Shannonville exit. Turn right (south) to Hwy # 2. Turn left (east) onto Hwy #2; the track is approximately 6 kilometers on the left (north) side of the highway. If coming from the East. Take 401 West to the Marysville exit. Go South on Hwy #49 to the junction of Hwy #2 turn right (west), the track is approximately 3 kilometers on the right (north) side.

### **Required equipment**

Students must provide a suitable motorcycle for the school. The motorcycle does not have to be a vintage bike nor does it have to be race prepared. The motorcycle will require the following:

- lockwired oil drain plug and oil filter
- drain all antifreeze and replace with water only (water wetter accepted)
- all lights and mirrors must be removed and/or taped over
- tires must be in good condition
- both brakes must be functional and in good condition

Riders will be required to wear the following:

- full leathers either one piece or zip together two piece
- leather boots, minimum height of 8 inches from the top of the sole and overlapping the pants
- full coverage helmet with faceshield, helmets must be certified by the manufacturer as Snell M2005, BSI 6658 Type A or ECE/22-05 approved
- back protector is recommended and required for competition

### **Schedule**

- 7:00 AM Registration opens
- 8:00 AM Classroom session
- 11:30 AM Lunch
- 12:00 PM Mandatory Riders Meeting
- 12:20 PM On track sessions begin
- 2:45 PM School ends with graduation and debriefing

## **Cost**

The cost of the school is \$125.00.

## **Membership requirements**

All applicants must be 2009 VRRRA members.

All selected applicants must apply for by a VRRRA racing membership prior to attending the school. Successful students will receive their racing membership after the school.

Riders who enter a VRRRA event in Ontario without a RACE licence will be required to pay an insurance fee for each event.

## **Registration Requirements**

We will only accept pre-entry for the school. Applications will not be accepted at the track. The school is limited to 40 riders.

In order to allow everyone an equal opportunity to register, the application form will be posted on the VRRRA website ([www.vrra.ca](http://www.vrra.ca)) at the beginning of February. School and membership applications, with cheque or money order attached, will be received until Feb 28, 2009. All applications will be issued a number when received and a draw will take place for the successful applicants. A reserve list will be created in case any rider withdraws. Unsuccessful applicants will have their application, and cheque or money order, returned after the draw.

The school will operate rain or shine. If for any reason you cannot attend, we will attempt to fill your seat. Should we be unable to do so there will not be any refunds issued. Any refund issued will subject to a \$20 administration fee.
