

Vintage Road Racing Association (VRRRA)

Riders School

The VRRRA in conjunction with Racing Associates Canada Events (RACE) will present a school to instruct basic riding skills for organized road racing competition. Riders who successfully pass this course will be eligible for a VRRRA racing membership, and are also eligible to apply for a RACE licence. Riders under the age of 18 years at the time of the scheduled school must contact the VRRRA to obtain an underage consent form prior to application.

Sidecar School

There will be a sidecar school running concurrent with the Rider's school. This is a chance to obtain your credentials to drive a rig or be a passenger. Drivers must supply their own machine. Please complete the rider's school form and write on the top "Sidecar Driver" or "Sidecar Passenger" and submit as per the instructions. Application forms will be accepted until April 15.

If you currently have, or are eligible for, a VRRRA racing membership you do not need to attend the general part of the classroom training and the fee is reduced to \$100. You will have to attend the sidecar classroom training immediately after the general session and all skid pad and track sessions.

Date and Location

Directions

Take the 401 East of Belleville, Ontario to the Shannonville exit. Turn right (south) to Hwy # 2. Turn left (east) onto Hwy #2; the track is approximately 6 kilometers on the left (north) side of the highway. If coming from the East. Take 401 West to the Marysville exit. Go South on Hwy #49 to the junction of Hwy #2 turn right (west), the track is approximately 3 kilometers on the right (north) side.

Required equipment

Students must provide a suitable motorcycle for the school. The motorcycle does not have to be a vintage bike nor does it have to be race prepared. The motorcycle will require the following:

- lockwire oil drain plug and oil filter
- drain all antifreeze and replace with water only (water wetter accepted)
- all lights and mirrors must be removed and/or taped over
- tires must be in good condition
- both brakes must be functional and in good condition

Riders will be required to wear the following:

- full leathers either one piece or zip together two piece
- leather boots, minimum height of 8 inches from the top of the sole and overlapping the pants
- full coverage helmet with faceshield, helmets must be certified by the manufacturer as Snell M2005, BSI 6658 Type A or ECE/22-05 approved
- back protection (separate protector or built into leathers)

Cost

The cost of the school is \$150.00.

Membership requirements

All applicants must be 2010 VRRRA members.

All selected applicants must apply, and pay for a VRRRA racing membership prior to attending the school. Successful students will receive their racing membership after the school.

Registration Requirements

We will only accept pre-entry for the school. Applications will not be accepted at the track.

The riders school is limited to 40 riders. In order to allow everyone an equal opportunity to register, we will hold a draw if we receive more than 40 applications before February 28, 2010. All applications received by February 28, 2010 will be issued a number and, if required, a draw will take place to select the successful applicants. A reserve list will be created in case any rider withdraws. Unsuccessful applicants will have their application and money returned after the draw.

The school will operate rain or shine. If we have a full riders school (40 riders) and for any reason you cannot attend, we will attempt to fill your seat. If the school is not full, no refunds will be considered.
