

2017 Am-Can Championship Series Rules

- All participating racers must hold a current year competition membership in good standing from either AHRMA, USCRA, or VRRRA.
- There are two Teams in the Am-Can Championship: Team Canada and Team USA
- Riders must register for either Team USA or Team Canada per event by choosing either team on your registration document or through Series Tracker during pre-registration.
- Am-Can Championship points are only available at sanctioned events. The list of events is on the front page of the website.
- Registration to earn Am-Can Championship points must be done through the sanctioning body's registration process. Registering racers will pay a \$5.00 per day registration fee in both USCRA and AHRMA, and a weekend fee of \$10.00 in VRRRA. Collected fees are in the denomination of the hosting organization.
- That single fee allows the racer to automatically accumulate Am-Can Championship points for every race they enter for any finishing position 1-15.
- The points matrix is as follows: 18,15,13,12,11,10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1
- Earned points will accumulate towards both the Team total **AND** the Individual Racer's National ranking.
- The Am-Can Championship Series will tally, track, and publish the top ten Individual Racer points within each team throughout the season.
- Racers may enter and accumulate points for their Team and their Individual National ranking at any sanctioned Am-Can Championship Event both within their home racing organization AND abroad.
- **Any Racer attending a sanctioned Am-Can Championship Event in the opposing team's country will earn DOUBLE points for every finish towards both their Team and Individual National Ranking**
- Racers who do not have machinery with equivalent classes in the other organizations may apply with the host organization for inclusion in comparative classes. All contact information is on the front page of the website.
- All earned points accumulate throughout the season for each Team and will be handicapped by the bulk number of team entries to produce a 2017 Am-Can Champion Team.
- Top 3 racers from each team will be awarded Am-Can Championship medallions at each Sanctioned event.
- Top ten Individual National Ranking medallions will be awarded annually
- Am-Can Championship Series winning Team will be awarded the Series Trophy to be displayed at future events.
